

PROGRAMMA GARA E PROTOCOLLO ANTI COVID 19

In order to comply with the rules of general health care and distancing provided for the Covid 19 pandemic, the following guidelines will follow the Regulations "Italy is racing again. Temporary organizational protocol not staged". This document is constantly evolving, so before the event takes place it will be necessary to check for any updates

It is understood that the issuance of new rules by the Central or Territorial Government may at any time cancel the provisions of the Protocol currently in force.

GENERAL BEHAVIORAL RULES

- Put on the mask and keep the social distance of mt. 1
- Avoid mixed use of bottles and glasses
- Store handkerchiefs or wipes (disposable) used during the race in special pockets and then throw them in special baskets prepared by the organization
- Before and after circular physical activity, always with masks or suitable nose / mouth protection
- As soon as possible, after physical activity, wash your hands thoroughly with water or use disinfection products prepared by the organization
- Wash clothing worn during the race separately from other clothing.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose and mouth with your hands.
- In the presence of flu symptoms, avoid any type of physical activity.

GREEN PASS

Those who are entitled or will have to access the competition site must be in possession of one of the green CoVID-19 certifications and, for tracking, deliver the anti-CoVID19 self-declaration:

1. CoVID-19 green certification, which can be issued after the administration of the first dose of vaccine and is valid from the fifteenth day thereafter until the scheduled date of administration of the second dose (in

the case of a double dose vaccine). In any case, the green certification is valid for nine months from the completion of the vaccination cycle;

2. recovery from Sars-CoV-2 infection (valid for 6 months);

3. carrying out a rapid molecular or antigenic test with a negative result for the Sars-CoV-2 virus (valid for 48 hours for antigenic - 72 hours for molecular - valid as of November 14, 2021.) The above provisions do not apply to subjects excluded by age from the vaccination campaign and to exempt subjects on the basis of suitable medical certification issued according to the criteria defined in a circular from the Ministry of Health. For those coming from non-EU countries it will be mandatory to have a certificate of successful vaccination recognized by the EU or the negative result of a PCR or antigenic swab of II or III generation performed within

Verification of possession and validity of the GREEN PASS will be carried out at the entrance to the Expo Marathon Village.

RACE BIB COLLECTION WITH DISPOSABLE CHIP, TSHIRT AND RACE BAG

48 hours before the race (therefore valid on 14 November 2021)

The race bib is personal and cannot be sold or exchanged. It must be attached to the chest with four pins in such a way as to be fully visible: it cannot be folded and must remain intact. It will be possible to collect the bib with the chip as well as the race bag at **EXPO 'MARATHON VILLAGE** - set up at **ARTIFICERIE ALMAGIA' via dell 'Almagià n. 2** - away on the following days:

• Friday 12 November from 12.00 to 19.00

• Saturday 13 November from 9.30 to 19.30

• Sunday 14 November from 7.15 to 9.00 at the **PLANETARIUM located inside the PUBLIC GARDENS - Viale**Santi Baldini n. 4

Access to the Expo 'Marathon Village race will be regulated upon entry by a security service that will monitor the number of restricted accesses and respect for the distance of waiting athletes (1m).

At the entrance, possession of the green pass will be verified upon presentation of the confirmation letter (paper or visible on smartphone). Subsequently, at the bib collection desk, after presenting the anti covid 19 certification (downloadable here), a paper bracelet will be delivered that will allow direct entry to the grid on the morning of the race.

N.B. PROXIES FOR BIB COLLECTION ARE NOT ALLOWED - each member participating in the race is the only one authorized to collect their bib.

LOCAL ATHLETES AND FROM NEARBY AREAS ARE RECOMMENDED TO COLLECT THE BIB ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY,

TO LEAVE SPACE FOR THOSE COMING FROM OUTSIDE REGION, PROVINCE ON SUNDAY MORNING.



WHO CAN TRAVEL FROM ABROAD TO ITALY WITH COVID 19 GREEN CERTIFICATION

The green COVID 19 certification simplifies entry into Italy from European Union countries, from other European countries such as Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, Andorra and the Principality of Monaco and from Israel. To enter Italy, the traveler's Covid 19 Green Certification must certify one of the following conditions:

- have completed the prescribed anti-SARS-CoV-2 vaccination course
- or be cured of COVID-19 (the validity of the certificate is 180 days from the date of the first positive swab)
- or having made a molecular or antigenic swab carried out 48 hours before entering Italy with negative results. Children under 6 are exempted from taking the pre-departure swab.

EXEMPTIONS

Those who have vaccination exemption certificates are requested to document them by sending an email to info@maratonadiravenna.com (BEFORE BIB COLLECTION).

ANTIGENIC SWABS

On Friday 12 and Saturday 13 November, at the S. TERESA PHARMACY - Via De Gasperi n. 71 - Ravenna, for those who need it, it will be possible to undergo the RAPID ANTIGENIC PAD at a cost of € 15.00. Reservations must be sent well in advance to the email address - info@maratonadiravenna.com

It is necessary to show up with a health card and smartphone.

PRE - POST RACE MEASURES

- In order to avoid the promiscuity of flows between athletes / staff (members or employees of the competition) and others (citizenship present in any capacity: from the athletes' technicians to passers-by, etc ...) the following indications will be implemented:
- Signaling and delimitation: access to the pre-race area (from outside or from dedicated parking lots); pre-match warm-up area; access to the departure area; exit from the arrival area;
- Maintain and ensure that the minimum social distance prescribed (1 meter) is always and in any case maintained;
- Control figures (security service staff) are provided to control the access of athletes in the various sectors who will identify the athletes and monitor compliance with the distances
- 40 chemical toilets will be available to be located partly along the route at the refreshment points, partly in Viale Santi Baldini 4) with dispensers inside for sanitizing hands
- There will be no changing room service and shower service



SHUTTLE SERVICE PRE - POST RACE

A shuttle service is available (pre and post race) that will accompany athletes and companions to the start / finish area.

Starting time - from 7.00

Return time - from 11.00

The collection points (adjacent to large car parks) are as follows:

- 1 Via Travaglini (Sva dealership Dakar)
- 2 Via Travaglini (Coop Teodora car park)
- 3 Via Trieste (Civil Motorization car park)
- 4- Viale Pallavicini drop-off area on arrival and collection point for return
- 5 Pala De Andrè drop off point

Shuttle bus with 114 available (80% capacity)

BAG DEPOSIT - PUBLIC GARDENS - Viale Santi Baldini n. 4

Each athlete will receive, together with the bib, a sticker with their bib number to be applied to the personal belongings bag.

In the departure / arrival area - PUBLIC GARDENS - viale Santi Baldini n. 4 - structures will be set up where the participants, according to the bib number, will be able to deliver the bags of clothing; they must be collected by showing their bib number.

Only official event bags will be accepted and not large personal bags such as trolleys and / or suitcases.

Mandatory delivery DEPARTURE AREA: from 7.15 am to 8.45 am

While ensuring the utmost care, the organization will not be held responsible for any loss / damage to the effects contained in the bag, we therefore recommend that you do not bring any valuables.

Redelivery that allows rapid flow and outflow and respecting the interpersonal distance of 1 m

ACCESS TO THE STARTING AREA AND THE STARTING GRIDS

The athletes will be divided into sectors of 2000 athletes each (maximum number) with relative bib number (obtained from the best time that the athlete declared during registration) and conveyed inside the Public Gardens (viale Santi Baldini n.4):

- at the entrance to the sector, they must be identified with certainty (bib number present in the list delivered to the employee), they must wear a mask
- within the sector they will have to respect the interpersonal distance of mt. 1 taking care to avoid gatherings;

• a few minutes before departure they will be accompanied by the security service on a delimited path,

maintaining the distance of 1 meter until they arrive at the entrance to the departure areaAlla partenza gli

The bibs will have different colors, corresponding to the assignment grid. It is not possible to enter a grid other than the

one assigned, otherwise the athlete will be subject to disqualification.

The time of each athlete will be detected electronically from his passage on the starting line at the start of the race, to

his arrival with passage on the Finish line and with the split times.

It is absolutely forbidden to leave any garment or object inside the starting grids before the start. Each athlete will have

to get rid of sacrifice jerseys, heating capes or the like before entering the grids.

DEPARTURE METHOD

The start will be divided into grids of up to 2000 athletes who will be spaced out for a sufficient time to allow the athletes

to flow out. The starting grid of each participant will be clearly indicated on the race bib by a specific color. Access to

the individual starting grids will be manned by our staff who will allow access only to athletes wearing a bracelet, bib

combined with each grid and to authorized personnel recognizable by a special pass. The grids can be accessed ONLY

by wearing the mask; after the start the athletes

they will continue to wear it for the first 500 meters after which they will be able to place it on their arm and put it back

on upon arrival (if it is lost or no longer usable, the organization will provide a new one).

Timing on the starting line with chip / transponder.

MEASURES DURING THE RACE

Although the social value of running cannot be denied and although in competition the closeness between athletes is

possible (sometimes inevitable), a behavior of general awareness and risk mitigation is recommended, an example of

civil liability that determines the conduct. of each participant.

During the race, lateral spacing of at least 1m to the right and 1m to the left and about 5 meters from the athlete in

front is recommended.

The organization will make several groups of race assistants ("race controllers") available free of charge, clearly

recognizable and in charge of running the marathon at a constant pace to reach the finish line in the following times:

3h00 - 3h15 - 3h30 - 3h45 - 4h00 - 4h15 - 4h30 - 4h45 - 5h00 - 5h30 - 6h00.

RESTAURANTS

Water will be available at all refreshment points. In addition, EthicSport gels will also be available at the 10km (this gel

must be collected at the Ethic Sport stand in Expo and brought directly by the athlete, 20km, 30km refreshment points.

After the finish line, a refreshment bag with water, EthicSport products and fresh fruit and dried fruit will be provided.



OUTFLOW FROM THE ARRIVAL AREA

WE COUNT ON YOU !!!!- Help us keep the finish line clear for those who come after you!

After the finish, the athletes will have to wear a mask and will be directed to the obligatory route, during which they will collect:

- any surgical mask (if necessary)
- participation medal (delivered by hand)
- final refreshment
- It will be strictly FORBIDDEN to stop beyond the arrival point.
- In the exit route, the rules for spacing 1 m from one athlete to another must be respected.

ANTI-COVID LEGISLATION FOR THE PUBLIC

Access to the competition area will be prohibited for anyone who does not fall into the following categories: athletes, organization, judges, timekeepers, technicians.

The area dedicated to the event will be cordoned off and, along the course of all distances, it is strictly forbidden to the public - who must wear a mask for the entire time and maintain the correct distance to approach the athletes during the competition.

The transit of all vehicles including bicycles will be prohibited on the race course. Violators will be stopped and punished according to the law.

THE ORGANIZATION RESERVES THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO MAKE CHANGES TO THIS REGULATION AT ITS OWN DISCRETION.
